Notification of Upcoming Well Destruction Activities

Former Exxon Service Station 7-0238 2200 E. 12th Street, Oakland, California 94606

Mr. Wong:

At the request of ExxonMobil Environmental Services (EMES), on behalf of Exxon Mobil Corporation, Cardno ERI is notifying you of upcoming well destruction activities at the subject site. As part of the ongoing environmental investigation at the subject site, 11 on-site wells are being destroyed by over-drilling and pressure grouting. The work is being performed at the direction of Alameda County, Environmental Health Services (the County).

From May 22 through May 25, 2012, Cardno ERI will be working in the vicinity of the subject site. A generalized site map with well locations is attached.

Specific field activities related to the work include:

- Subsurface clearance prior to over-drilling.
- Pressure grouting.
- Over-drilling with auger rig.
- Repaving surface.

Soil cuttings and rinsate water generated during field activities will be placed in 55-gallon drums and stored at the subject site pending characterization and disposal.

The proposed schedule of activities is outlined below. Cardno ERI encourages you or a representative to attend the Project Orientation Meeting, scheduled for Tuesday, May 15, 2011 at 9:00 A.M., to discuss the work scope and associated logistical and safety issues.
