Response to letter dated December 7, 1992 and follow-up of telephone conversation on January 14, 1993 concerning proposed work in the Work Plan for Additional Subsurface Investigation (RESNA, November 25, 1992) at ARCO Station 2185, 9800 East 14th street, Oakland, California.

Dear Mr. Chan:

As per our telephone conversation on January 14, 1993, we have addressed the concerns presented in your the subject letter in the following ways:

1. Assuming the gradient, as shown in this report, it appears that both MW-6 and MW-7 would be better located somewhat north of their proposed locations on Plate 5.

As discussed, we will move the locations of onsite monitoring well MW-6 and offsite monitoring well MW-7 to the north of the locations proposed on Plate 5 of the work plan. There are trees in the immediate area of proposed offsite monitoring well which may slightly alter the exact placement of the well. Also, as discussed, we are in the process of obtaining the necessary permits from the City of Oakland and CalTrans for the installation of this offsite monitoring well MW-7. During the interim, we have scheduled the installation of onsite wells MW-5 and MW-6 for January 20, 1993, which will allow us to proceed with the proposed Aquifer Pumping Test.

2. Please keep in mind that if the pump test performed on MW-3 does not show sufficient influence on MW-2, you should consider pumping from MW-2 as well.

## Letter of Response ARCO Station 2185, Oakland, California

As agreed, if monitoring well MW-2 does not show sufficient influence during the aquifer pumping test to be performed using MW-3, we will attempt to pump from well MW-2 as suggested.
