This letter provides an update on investigation and remedial activities conducted for the above-referenced site. This update covers site activities performed during December 1992, and site activities anticipated for the month of January 1993.

December 1992 Activities

- Performed monthly groundwater monitoring.
- Continued the permitting process to obtain encroachment and excavation permits for installation of one offsite monitoring well from the City of Oakland. The City of Oakland informed us that East 14th Street is also part of CalTrans Highway 185 and that we must obtain both City of Oakland and CalTrans encroachment permits for the installation of offsite monitoring well(s). This additional permitting requirement will delay the actual installation of the offsite monitoring well(s) by approximately 6 to 8 weeks.
- Submitted Final Third Quarter 1992 Quarterly Monitoring Report to ARCO and regulators.

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December 1992 Activities (Cont.)

- Received correspondence from ACHCSA concerning work proposed in work plan (RESNA, November 25, 1992).

Work Anticipated for January 1993

- Continue monthly groundwater monitoring.
- Continue with attempts to obtain encroachment and excavation permits from City of Oakland, and encroachment permit from CalTrans for the installation of offsite groundwater monitoring well(s).
- Upon resolving work plan issues with ACHCSA, schedule field work. Obtain Well Construction Permits from the Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, Zone 7, for the installation of groundwater monitoring wells. Information from aquifer test to be used in Remedial Action Plan due to Regulatory Agencies on June 1, 1993.
