Paresh,

Per our conversation earlier this morning, this email serves to request approval from the Alameda County Environmental Health to properly abandon wells MW-3, MW-6, MW-10, and MW-13 at the subject site. The property is in the process of being divested. The new property owner is scheduled to raze and rebuild the Station building. As you may recall, wells MW-1 and MW-8 were abandoned earlier this summer in anticipation of construction activities. We have recently been informed that the new property owner is giving up approximately 12 feet of property to the north to allow for widening of East Stanley Boulevard and the addition of a right turn lane. Wells MW-6, MW-10, and MW-13 will no longer on Station 6113 property once this is completed. Additionally, we have also recently learned that well MW-3 is within the construction demolition area on the property. Accordingly, it is recommended that wells MW-3, MW-6, MW-10, and MW-13 be properly abandoned prior to commencement of construction activities.

Once raze/rebuild activities are complete, the new site layout will be surveyed and replacement well locations will be proposed.
