Dear Ms. Hugo:

This letter provides an update on investigation and remedial activities conducted for the above-referenced site. This update covers site activities performed during March 1993, and site activities anticipated for the month of April 1993.

**March 1993 Activities**

- Performed groundwater monitoring.
- Completed installation of subsurface remediation piping in conjunction with product-line removal and replacement at the site. Heavy rains in December through February have caused significant delays (3 months) in attempting to complete this work.
- Drilled and installed two offsite and one onsite groundwater monitoring wells (MW-10 through MW-12).
- Developed newly installed wells MW-10 through MW-12.
- Submitted final fourth quarter 1992 quarterly groundwater monitoring report.

**Work Anticipated for April 1993**

- Continue monthly groundwater monitoring.
- As a result of recent rains, water levels in all onsite monitoring wells have risen from 60 feet below grade to 25 feet below grade. ARCO is currently re-evaluating soil and groundwater remediation alternatives that may be applicable to this site as a result of higher water levels. This, in conjunction with the delays in product-line removal and replacement, will delay submission of a Remedial Action Plan (originally due on May 15, 1993) by up to 90 days.
- Survey newly installed wells MW-10 through MW-12.
