On behalf of the State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans), Shaw Environmental, Inc. (Shaw) has prepared this submittal in response to your letter dated October 5, 2010.

Your letter requested submittal of a Landowner Notification Form for the above site. Caltrans submitted the requested information in a letter dated January 9, 2007, a copy of which was emailed to you on September 8 and October 5, 2010. A copy of the letter is also contained in the Alameda County online records database and State Geotracker system. Per email correspondence with you on October 5th, we understand that no further documentation is needed to complete the landowner notification requirement.

Your letter also requested that existing monitoring wells at the site be destroyed, and a technical report documenting well decommissioning be submitted to Alameda County by December 5, 2010. As I am sure you are aware, the State of California does not have a budget in place for the current fiscal year. Unfortunately, Caltrans is unable to issue a contract for destruction of the wells until there is an approved State budget. Since the timing for completion of a State budget is uncertain, it is likely that Caltrans may be unable to complete the well destruction and submit the report within the timeframe requested. Caltrans is committed to providing the County with a proposed schedule for well destruction after the State budget is finalized and Caltrans is able to move forward with the well destruction work.
