Regarding the "Technical Report Request" in the July 10, 2009 letter from the ACEH;

Due August 25, 2009 - GeoTracker Upload Compliance

I've checked the GeoTracker website yesterday and it looks like all monitoring reports (GEO_REPORT) from the year 2000 to present and their associated lab data files (EDF) and groundwater elevation files (GEO_WELL) have been uploaded. I noted that 4 of the EDF that we uploaded for 2000-01 were somehow assigned incorrect years and requested that the info be corrected (see e-mail to GeoTracker helpdesk forwarded below). In addition, I uploaded the SCM Data Gap Workplan and the boring log files (GEO_BORE) for all 5 monitoring points.

The only thing we don't have uploaded to GeoTracker is the survey data (GEO_XY and GEO_Z) because a survey has not been done yet (ACEH is aware of this - a survey is proposed in the Workplan). As such, the site appears to be in full compliance with the GeoTracker upload requirements.

Due September 8, 2009 - Workplan Addendum

We should have an addendum to the Workplan to you no later than September 8th.

Due 30 Days after Sampling - Semi Annual Monitoring Reports

The next monitoring event is scheduled for September, 2009.
