Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) has reviewed the recently submitted document entitled, *Supplement to Feasibility Study/Corrective Action Plan* (Supplement) dated December 31, 2012, which was prepared by Stratus Environmental, Inc. for the subject site. ACEH staff has reviewed the case file in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board's Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP).

Based on our review, ACEH is concerned that the site conceptual model (SCM) does not adequately assess groundwater conditions at the site, and has questions regarding Stratus' determination of the deep and shallow groundwater zones, associated groundwater gradients, and the appropriateness of the monitoring well network. Therefore, ACEH would like to invite you to a meeting at our office located at 1131 Harbor Bay Parkway, Suite 250 in Alameda to discuss the site prior to making a determination on the appropriateness of the corrective action plan. Subsequent to the meeting, ACEH will prepare a formal directive letter incorporating the strategy discussed in the meeting and the requisite work elements and schedule for moving the site forward in an efficient and focused manner.

Please contact us to schedule a meeting time and your proposed list of attendees. Prior to the meeting, ACEH will provide a Data Gap Identification Tool (DGIT) to help focus data collection efforts, and sequence activities to enable data collection in the fewest mobilizations possible.
