Dear Mr. Chan:

As you requested in your November 4, 1996 letter to R. Jeff Granberry of Shell Oil Products Company (Shell), Cambria Environmental Technology, Inc. (Cambria) is submitting this work plan to evaluate whether there are potential sensitive receptors near the site referenced above and to use the data to perform a Risk Based Corrective Action assessment (RBCA). Our proposed scope of work is presented below.

Proposed Scope of Work

As you requested in your letter to Shell and confirmed in your December 16, 1996 telephone conversation with Paul Waite of Cambria, we will investigate the risk to potential sensitive receptors in the vicinity of the Shell service station. This investigation will involve the following tasks:

- We will review available records for water wells or other potential receptors in the site vicinity;
- We will review available building records to identify buildings that have basements; and
- We will observe neighboring properties to look for structures that may have basements.

Our review of potential sensitive receptors will be limited to properties down gradient and on the same side of High Street as the Shell station. You indicated that Chevron USA Products Company (Chevron) will be responsible for conducting a similar investigation on properties down gradient and on the same side of High Street as the Chevron station at 4265 Foothill Boulevard.

We will conduct the investigation and submit the results to your office by the first quarter of 1997. After you receive the results, we will contact you regarding performing a RBCA for this site.
