

9/9/87 PG&E in process of relocating utility pole, excavated to place guidewire. Smelled 'gasoline', foreman called applicable authorities and pulled the crew off the job.

9/15/87 Dan spoke w/ Kubo re whatever reports, paper he had and with whom he had dealt.

9/17/87 Alameda County Health Dept handling problem. Took preliminary samples at site of PG&E excavation.

9/22/87 Seto w/ Alameda Cty Health Dept said lab report showed 45,000 PPM.

Tak called Kubo. Kubo said still had not contacted Mobil, but would call his old rep tonight. Advised Kubo of ACHD findings of 45K PPM sample.

9/23/87 Tak w/ Jim Bowers, Subsurface Consultants.

Discussed present circumstances. Bowers outlined in what manner we should proceed.

Bowers stated that in discussing problem w/ Dan and Don Edgar, he was adamant in recommending we not accept the offsite responsibilities.

9/24/87 Tak w/ Don Edgar. Discussed situation and agreed we find out the extent of problem and worry about who pays later.

9/24/87 Tak w/ Kubo. Advised him we spoke w/ Jane Keith. of Mobil. We to do borings and wells to see the extent of the problem. We to go to him, he to Mobil. Kubo not assured they will pay, but it is what Jane hinted....

9/24/87 Tak w/ Bill Rudolph (Subsurface Consultants). Problem is away from the tanks - oil-like (not gas). As a guess, he thinks limited. TH "If not on our property, what happens?" BR "Oil company may fight paying."

9/24/87 Tak w/ Jane Keith, Mobil. Keith said to proceed and find out extent of problem, go back thru Kubo to them re paying and worry about it later. We're to call her before cleanup just to advise on what's happening.

9/28/87 Tak w/ Jim Bowers. Discussed in what manner testing would be accomplished to isolate area of contamination.

9/30/87 Bowers advised problem is localized under sidewalk on 150th. Tak gave Bowers the go to proceed w/

testing. RE Bowers recommendation that if concentrations borderline, we argue for permission to leave, TH replied we didn't intend to spend too much time in arguing and would rather get on w/ the clean-up so we can get "up". "We can deal w/ the money aspects after the fact."

- 10/1/87 Tak w/ Bowers. Bowers spoke w/ Seto who gave the nod that all done so far, okay. Bowers to send the info on tests to Seto who will discuss w/ Reg'l H²O Board. Thinks we can get together w/ Board mid-week 10/12.
- 10/1/87 Tak w/ Kubo. Advised of status to date.
- 10/9/87 Bowers called w/ lab results. They had assumed we were dealing with hydrocarbons, but test were negative. Tests now must be re-run for mineral-based oil. Testing will re-commence on 10/12.
- 10/13/87 Bowers advised results of second tests won't be available until 10/15-16.
- 10/13/87 Tak to Kubo. Adv. mineral oil lab tests ready Thurs/Fri. Told him we called Jane Keith for well contamination results. We'll contact him when more info available.
- 10/13/87 Keith called. No results - nothing in file re monitoring wells.
- 10/15/87 Kubo to Tak - Read letter from Roller dated 2/18/87 saying Mobil will use usual procedure re Reg'l H²O
- 10/15/87 Keith advised Mobil has not done any H²O analysis as they did not install well.
- She says the usual situation is that the person installing the well is responsible to give report to Co. & Reg'l H²O on row where installed and the results of tests.
- 10/15/87 Bowers - Three solvents positive and transmission oil plus some minor localized gasoline. Solvents a problem; will require a water monitoring well. On scale of '10', thinks a 2 or 3 and we can remove soil and worry about well later.
- 10/21/87 Tests rsvd. Positive for hydrocarbon oil products. Relatively localized w/i area of PG&E's excavation.
