Dear Mr. Seery:

On behalf of Mobil Oil Corporation, the following is a response to our telephone conversations on December 3 and 17, 1993, and to your letter dated December 3, 1993, regarding the work plan submitted on November 19, 1993, for a preliminary site investigation at former Mobil Oil Station 04-FGN, 14994 East 14th Street, San Leandro, California.

Based on the information you provided, we propose to relocate the groundwater monitoring wells as shown on the enclosed site plan. As a precautionary measure, we generally perform an underground utility survey before drilling. At this site, we will attempt to locate the former product lines, if still present, using an electromagnetic survey. Based on our recent site visit to locate a well that you indicated may exist near the former underground tank cavity, we were unable to reach a definitive conclusion as to its existence. However, we will further investigate the well's existence during field activities.

Field work is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of January 3, 1994, therefore your immediate response to the work plan will be greatly appreciated. Please call Mr. Steve Pao of Mobil Oil Corporation if you have questions or need additional information.
