Dear Ms. Evans:

On behalf of Shell Oil Products Company (Shell), Cambria Environmental Technology (Cambria) is submitting this letter to confirm our Thursday, March 5, 1998 telephone conversation. As you know, Cambria has been pursuing an encroachment permit from the City of Oakland for drilling activities at the site referenced above. We are currently in the process of obtaining the various legal documents required for this permit. While Cambria is actively pursuing the requested legal documentation, we do not anticipate receiving the permits before March 14, which will be 60 days after the date of your January 13, 1998 letter approving Cambria's *MTBE Investigation Workplan*. We will complete this investigation as soon as possible upon receiving the permits from the City of Oakland, which we anticipate happening by the end of this month. Until that time, we will keep you updated on the progress of our permit application process.

Unless I hear otherwise from your office, I will proceed with the original work plan for the installation of these wells. Attached please find a site plan showing the revised boring/well locations based on underground utility locations noted during Cambria's March 5, 1998 site visit.

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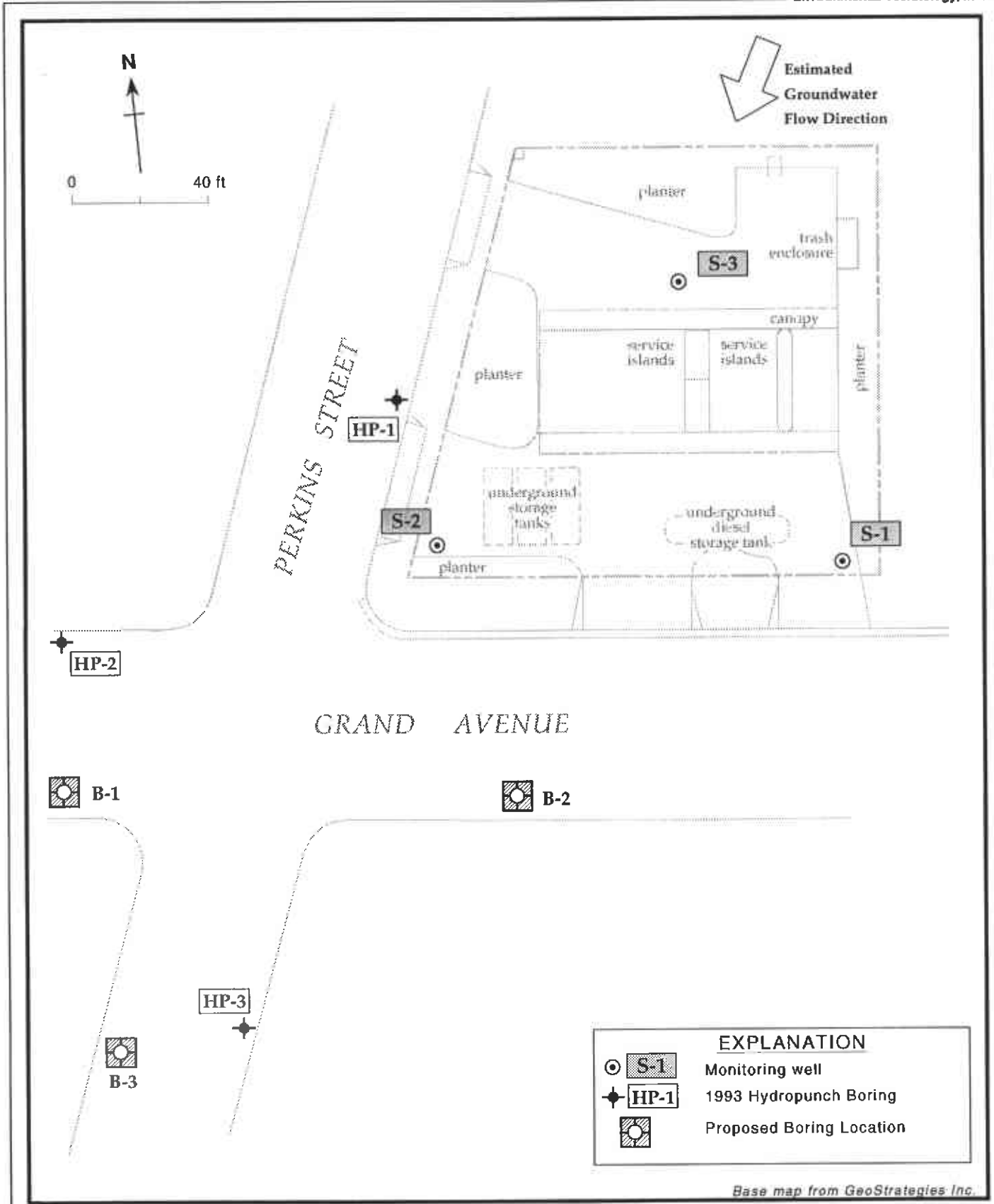


Figure 2. Proposed Boring Locations - Shell Service Station WIC #204-5510-0204, 350 Grand Avenue, Oakland, California
