We've (ACEH) been in the process of cleaning up GeoTracker as a part of the SWRCB Resolution 2009-0042 review process and found that DTSC has been handling the area of this old ACEH case. It appeared reasonable to transfer oversight of ACEH Case RO 431 at the site to DTSC, and this was done on March 12<sup>th</sup>.
