The Port of Oakland ("Port") is in receipt of your letter of July 3, 2008 regarding the former Union Pacific Motor Freight Underground Storage Tank ("UST") "Site". The Port has not submitted groundwater monitoring data because all the wells were removed during extensive redevelopment of the Site and the adjacent APL Container Terminal. The construction work and the well removals were with the knowledge of Environmental Health at Alameda County initially through Mr. Barney Chan and later through Mr. Steven Plunkett. The wells will be replaced by the Port in the near future, when construction work is complete.

Unless I hear otherwise, the Port will continue to coordinate with Mr. Plunkett on the replacement of wells at this site, and will notify you when they are installed and provide you with the monitoring schedule. Results will be uploaded to the Geotracker database once monitoring commences.
