Enclosed is a copy of the records from the hand bailing activities for two groundwater monitoring wells and one recovery well at the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Motor Freight Facility in Oakland, California. As indicated in the records, non-aqueous phase liquid petroleum hydrocarbon (oil) has not been measured in groundwater monitoring wells OKUS-W4 and -W5 and approximately one gallon per week of oil has been bailed from recovery well RW. The skimming device in the recovery well RW was installed on April 29, 1994 and commenced operation during the week of May 2, 1994.
