

Petitions must be filed within 30 days from the date of the action/inaction. 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**Responsible Party Identification Background**

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

### Responsible Party Identification

#### Existence of Unauthorized Release

On September 29, 1986, Xerxes Fiberglass, Inc. the UST manufacturer, inspected an 800-gallon used oil UST at the site and determined that the bottom had ruptured. When the used oil UST was removed on December 4, 1986, light non-aqueous phase liquid and petroleum-saturated soil was observed in the excavation area. A passive skimmer was installed at the site in June 1986 to recover free-phase diesel fuel in the area of four 12,000-gallon diesel USTs. The release was estimated at approximately 250 gallons of diesel fuel. These facts along with subsequent site investigation activities confirm that unauthorized releases have occurred at the site.

#### Responsible Party Identification

GI Trucking Company (currently dba Estes West) was the business owner, tank owner, and property owner at the time of an unauthorized release. GI Trucking Company was a subsidiary of Arkansas Best Corporation. Estes Express Lines purchased GI Trucking in August 2005. GI Trucking dba Estes West is a responsible party because GI Trucking owned and operated the underground storage tank system from which an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 1), was the owner of property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3), and had control of the UST system at the time of or following unauthorized releases (Definition 4).

Treadark Real Estate Corporation purchased the property on or about July 27, 2005. Treadark Real Estate Corporation is a subsidiary of Arkansas Best Corporation. Treadark Real Estate Corporation and Arkansas Best Corporation are a responsible party because they were the former property owner (Definition 3).

Estes Terminals California LLC purchased the property on or about July 28, 2005. Estes Terminals California LLC is a responsible party because they are the current property owner (Definition 3).
