Hi Barb,

I wanted to give you a quick status update on the off-site well installation at RO#448, 1725 Park Street, Alameda. You responded to our work plan (thank you) and we immediately began the encroachment permitting process; however, we've hit a snag with the encroachment permitting. There are some insurance and indemnification issues (similar to the City of Oakland permits you're familiar with) that Exxon Mobil is working on with their legal counsel and as soon as they resolve those issues with the City we'll get back on track with the well permitting and installation. Our installation report isn't due until December 30th so we still have time and we'll do our best to keep things moving forward, but I don't really know what to expect from the City of Alameda. If they are as difficult to deal with as the City of Oakland, it will set our field work back, but we'll hope for faster results with them. I'll keep you posted.
