I hope you enjoyed your Thanksgiving break. I wanted to give you a status update on our off-site well installation at 1725 Park Street, Alameda. We began the encroachment permitting process upon receiving work plan approval from the ACEH, but the encroachment permit application contains indemnification language that must be reviewed by ExxonMobil's legal counsel. ExxonMobil will also have to sign the permit itself once the indemnification issues are ironed out, which may be problematic with insurance issues. This is very similar to the situation we are in with the encroachment permit in Oakland at RO#390. I am uncertain how long it will take to resolve the encroachment permitting issues but it would seem like another month would be adequate (however, with the holidays, it may be a bit longer). This would push the drilling to January or February. I would like to request an extension on the report deadline from December 30, 2009 to March 31, 2010. I'll keep you apprised of our progress. Please let me know if this is acceptable.
