#### Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

#### Responsible Party Identification

#### Existence of Unauthorized Release

In 1986, four gasoline USTs (2-5,000 gallon, 1-8,000-gallon and 1-10,000 gallon) were removed and replaced with three 10,000-gallon gasoline USTs. No reports were submitted for the tank removal. Sampling performed in 1988 for a Phase II investigation at the site revealed concentrations up to 1,400 ppm TPHg and 0.0670 ppm benzene indicating that a release occurred at the subject site.

#### Responsible Party Identification

Exxon Corporation purchased the property in December 1984 and is a responsible party for the site because they owned or operated an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance (Definition 1), they owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use (Definition 2), they owned a property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3) and they had control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).

Fuad Ateyeh purchased the property in 2001. Fuad Ateyeh is a responsible party for the site because he owns the property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance has occurred (Definition 3).
