Mr. Ateyeh:

At the request of ExxonMobil Environmental Services (EMES), on behalf of Exxon Mobil Corporation, Cardno ERI is notifying you of the upcoming drilling activities of two off-site soil borings (SB14 and SB15) and six on-site soil borings (SB16 through SB21) at the subject site. The boring locations are shown on the attached Generalized Site Plan. The borings will be core-cut and advanced using hand-auger equipment. Boring locations will be backfilled with grout and capped with concrete upon completion.

Specific field activities related to the work include:

- Drilling activities, February 28 and February 29, 2012
- Surveying activities, Date to be determined

Soil cuttings and rinsate water from drilling activities will be placed in 55-gallon drums and stored at the subject site pending characterization and disposal. Upon receipt of laboratory analytical results of soil samples from the drums, Cardno ERI will coordinate with EMES for disposal of the soil and water.

Cardno ERI appreciates your cooperation in ensuring that field work occurs safely and efficiently.

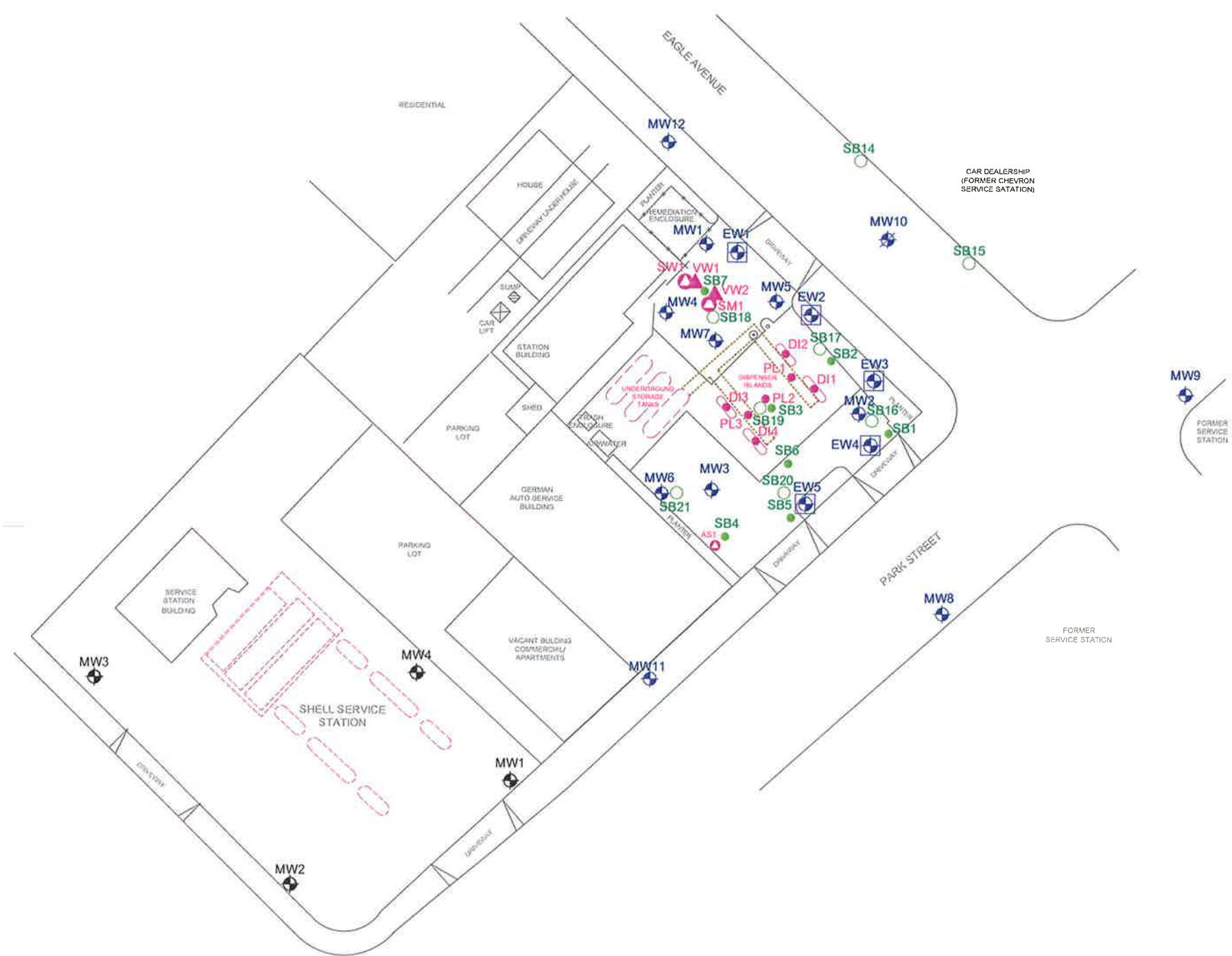
