Dear Mr. Borgh,

ACEH has reviewed the Corrective Action Plan that was submitted by Delta Environmental and has determined that additional information is needed on the proposed corrective action before we can approve the CAP. The location of the proposed injection points should be submitted as well as the area of the proposed excavation. Also, let me know what material will be used to backfill the excavation to ensure that a preferential pathway is not created. Once this information is received and ACEH concurs with the remediation plan, the 30 day public participation period will begin.

Following the end of the 30 day public participation period the CAP may be implemented provided that no comments opposing the CAP are received.
