Revisions to Work Plan for Environmental Site Assessment at Foothill Beacon, 16210 Foothill Blvd, San Leandro, California

Dear Mr. Seery:

As we discussed by phone today, Parker Environmental is making your requested revisions to the Subject Work Plan.

The first revision is to the proposed well locations on Figure 2. Based on your experience with monitoring wells nearby, the groundwater gradient is toward the southwest. One proposed well has been moved to take advantage of this information, and is show on the attached revised Figure 2.

Other revisions to the Work Plan include adding MTBE to the list of compounds to be analyzed; having a minimum of 72 hours between well construction, well development and well purging and sampling; and making a field decision concerning well screen size (.01 or .02) due to the fine grain soil size.


