Geo Solve will submit a work plan for further assessment, primarily focused on HAPC contaminants, with Stoddard solvent a secondary focus.

Briefly, the following elements will be incorporated

- Shallow soil samples in the area of (previous) borings B-6, B-9, and B-10
- B-6 "shallow" soil sample shall be between 0-5' depth. A hand sampler device may be used if undisturbed soil can be collected here.
- B-9/B-10 shallow samples - one in the 3-5' range, and one in the 7-10' range
- Property boundaries as depicted on maps (e.g., Fig. 7A in GeoSolve report) are to be confirmed
