

7-28-99

Steve ~~Southern~~ Southern of ACC Environmental informed me they pulled the boring as identified in their workplan dated 6-7-99, but has gotten only 3 VOC vials of water. I told him to let the water seepage overnight and try to collect more water tomorrow.

10-7-99

Steve Southern said he will send me a site map drawn to scale identifying sampling locations. In addition, he will contact the Lab to clarify the meaning of Refo. Limit - if it is detection limit.

7-31-2000

Spoke to Agsanah Salimpour of Chromlabs @ 925-484-1919 and asked her about the TEPA analysis. She said the test involved testing for the presence of Diesel and Motor Oil. She said she will look into the file to see if motor oil appears on the chromatograph of the ~~water~~ water sample from boring B-3 collected on 7-28-99. Diesel was detected in the sample.

5-29-99

Met with Pete Carrai and his consultant, Stephen Southern of PEC Environmental. Southern said he put together a workplan for me to review, but his Admin. Asst. may have forgot to mail it to me before she left the company. We went to the site to determine where the additional boring will be advanced. It was agreed that a boring will be ~~at~~ advanced within 10' of the downgradient direction from the remote cell. (Boring will be inside main building) I told Southern that soil samples should be taken every 5 feet, and the soil and groundwater samples must be tested for all the contaminants that are a concern to RWQCB. He will submit a workplan to me for approval.

3-22-99

Pete Carrai from City of Florida said he will do whatever it takes to get closure for this site. He will contact with an environmental consultant. Carrai is out of the office today, but returned my page. He will call tomorrow from his office.

3-23-99

Pete Carrai said ACC Environmental was given the okay to submit a workplan and to perform an investigation. The workplan will be ~~sent~~ submitted shortly. Carrai already has a draft plan from ACC.

5-26-99

Informed Pete Carrai that the ~~two~~ investigation that took place on-site on 4-21-99 was performed without the approval of Florida County. A workplan was never submitted by ACC Environmental prior to the work being performed. I told him that ACC never contacted me by phone either. He wants to schedule a meeting with them to iron out what needs to be done next.
