It is the responsibility of the primary or active Responsible Party to submit a letter to this agency, within 20 calendar days of receipt of this notice that identifies all current record owners of fee title. It is also the responsibility of the primary or active Responsible Party to certify to the local agency that the required notifications have been made at the time a cleanup or site closure proposal is made or before the local agency makes a determination that no further action is required. If property ownership changes in the future, you must notify this local agency within 20 calendar days from when you are informed of the change.

Any action or inaction by this local agency associated with corrective action, including responsible party identification, is subject to petition to the State Water Resources Control Board. Petitions must be filed within 30 days from the date of the action/inaction. To obtain petition procedures, please FAX your request to the State Water Board at (916) 341-5808 or telephone (916) 341-5752.

Pursuant to section 25296.10(c)(6) of the Health and Safety Code, a responsible party may request the designation of an administering agency when required to conduct corrective action. Please contact this office for further information about the designation process.

Responsible Party Identification

Existence of Unauthorized Release

On August 3, and September 1, 1999, soil bores SB-1 to SB-4 were installed at the subject site as a Phase II site investigation followup to a Phase I report. The Phase I report found that the subject site had previously been a service station. Concentrations up to 190,000 micrograms per liter (μ g/I) of Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), 3,500 μ g/I benzene, 4,000 μ g/I ethylbenzene, and 1,100 μ g/I Methyl Tert Butyl Either (MTBE) were detected in groundwater. No soil samples were collected. These data indicate than an unauthorized release had occurred.

Responsible Party Identification

Chevron Corporation (Chevron) owned or operated the USTs at the site. Chevron is a responsible party for site because it owned or operated an UST used for the storage of a hazardous substance (Definition 1), owned or operated the USTs immediately before the discontinuation of its use (Definition 2), and had control over an UST at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).

Russell Flynn and Norman Buckhart purchased the property in November 1981, and are responsible parties because they owned the property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3).

Patrick Ellwood, Richard Clancy, and E. Claire purchased the property in August 1985, and are responsible parties because they owned the property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3).

Patrick Ellwood purchased the property in December 1985, and has held the property in various configurations since (Patrick Ellwood et al, Ellwood Commercial, and College Square Associates). He / they are a responsible party because they owned the property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3).
