Thank you and Yane Nordhav of Baseline Environmental (Baseline) for participating in the meeting on May 21, 2014 regarding the Site Cleanup Program (SCP) case for Port of Oakland / APL / Berths 60-63, 1395 Middle Harbor Road, Oakland, Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) case number RO0000470. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the history of the site and the recently submitted documents entitled *Post Construction Closure Report* (PCCR), dated August 13, 2013, and the *Underground Storage Tank Closure Request* (RFC), dated June 13, 2013, prepared by Baseline for the subject site.

- Evaluate well screen intervals for the ground water monitoring wells associated with underground storage tanks EF-6 through EF-9 are appropriate to capture free phase; petroleum hydrocarbons;
- Provide ACEH Case Worker Barney Chan's correspondence regarding UST EF-14.
