Karel – Just checking in to see if you've had an opportunity to review the *Remediation Summary Report and First Semi-Annual Groundwater Monitoring Report* for the above referenced site in Castro Valley.

In the Conclusions and Recommendations section of the report Stantec had recommended "modification of the groundwater monitoring program from semi-annual to quarterly for three more quarters. If groundwater analytical results continue as recently demonstrated during the next three quarterly sampling events, Stantec will prepare a Site Closure Request based on the RWQCB's recently adopted Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy".

If possible, and with your concurrence, Stantec would like to initiate the next quarterly sampling event before the end of 2012, or potentially during the first quarter of 2013.
