Dear Officer Smith,

The following issues regarding the Workplan will be addressed.

- 1. We are planning to excavate and treat all soil that poses a potential source of groundwater contamination if the contamination is determined to exceed the proposed excavation depths of three to five feet.
- 2. All stockpiled materials will be Charecterized by sampling from each pile a 4 point composite sample. The following analyses will be performed: Any of the soil spoils generated from S-1 to S-7 will be chemically analyzed for TPH as gasoline (EPA Method 5020 or 5030), with BTEX distinction (EPA Method 8020). Any Samples generated from target S-8 will be chemically analyzed for Metals: Cadmium, Chromium, Lead, Nickel, Zinc. and Semi Volitile Organics (EPA Method 8270).
- 3. Also on the S-8 target, while testing for lead we will determine the soluble threshhold limit concentration (stlc) by laboratory analysis.
- 4. Site Security measures on the site will be established by total perimeter fencing, Where vehichles may have had access we will have State Certified K-Rail, and in addition to this we will have RED DANGER tape and YELLOW CAUTION tape. In addition we have requested only 5-day turn around time on all soil samples to minimize the exposure of the open site.

5. We will cover all stock piles with 4-6 mil visqueen until a permit from BAAQMD is aquired.

Thank you for your time and patience throughout this matter we will be giving advance notice to your department prior to the commencement of any work.
