At the request of ExxonMobil Environmental Services (EMES), on behalf of Exxon Mobil Corporation, Cardno is conducting well destruction activities at Former Exxon Service Station 73006, located at 720 High Street, Oakland, California.

The work will include the destruction of on-site and off-site monitoring wells associated with Former Exxon Service Station 73006. The locations of these wells are shown on the attached Generalized Site Plan. The work is scheduled to begin on January 11, 2016, and is anticipated to take approximately two weeks to complete. The work is being performed at the direction of the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency, Department of Environmental Health.

- Refinish the ground surface to match surrounding conditions.

Soil cuttings and rinsate water generated during drilling will be stored at Former Exxon Service Station 73006 pending characterization and disposal.
