Paula Sime and I discussed the 720 High Street site today in a phone conversation about the proposed hand auger borings that are being advanced on August 18 and 19, 2008. We discussed the potential that these borings may provide us with more information on downgradient migration and also that Cal Trans is currently doing seismic upgrades to Highway 880 and will not allow a replacement well for MW-1 to be installed until 2013. I am concerned that this Cal Trans restriction may also prevent installation of wells in the previously proposed locations (as per ERI's January 26, 2007 Soil and Groundwater Investigation Report with Updated Site Conceptual Model and Monitoring Well Replacement Recommendations). Based on these two pieces of information please review your proposed monitoring well locations and submit an updated map showing proposed well locations in the Soil and Water Investigation (SWI) Report that is prepared for the hand auger borings. Please submit the SWI report by **December 19, 2008**. Regards,
