At the request of ExxonMobil Refining and Supply, (formerly known as Exxon Company, U.S.A.) (ExxonMobil), Environmental Resolutions, Inc. (ERI) is notifying you of upcoming field work related to the destruction of groundwater monitoring wells MW7 through MW11, MW13, MW15, recovery wells RW1 through RW7, and vadose wells VW2 and VW3 at the subject site. A drilling rig will temporarily be on site during field activities. The work is scheduled for December 21 and 22, 2000.

The work will require that a drilling rig and two vehicles be on site for approximately two days. The locations of the wells are shown on the attached Generalized Site Plan. Soil generated during these activities will be temporarily stored on site pending disposal coordination.

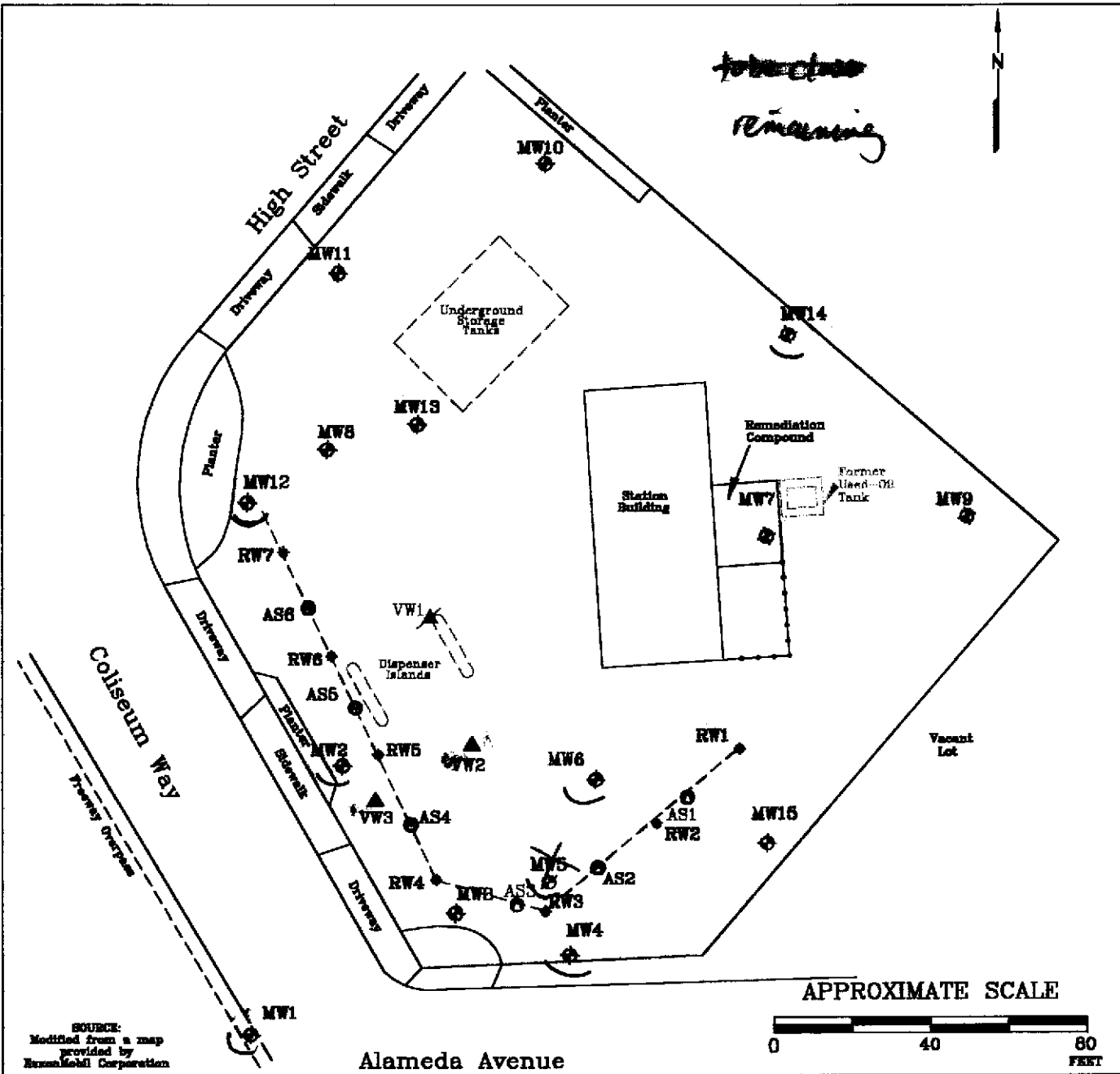
