At the request of ExxonMobil Oil Corporation (ExxonMobil), Environmental Resolutions, Inc. (ERI) has prepared this letter to document ERI's multiple attempts to locate groundwater monitoring wells MW4 and MW12 at the subject site. The locations of the wells are shown on the Generalized Site Plan (Plate 1). The wells were paved over by the property owner during station remodeling in March 2001. ERI attempted on two occasions to locate the wells using a metal detector and was unsuccessful.

In January 2003, ERI contracted Nor Cal Geophysical (Nor Cal), of Petaluma, California, to perform a ground-penetrating radar (GPR) survey in an attempt to locate the wells. Nor Cal surveyed the areas in the vicinity of the wells using a metal detector and GPR, and was unable to locate the wells. It appears that the well caps were broken off during paving and grading activities, and no metal components exist to assist in locating the wells using geophysical technology.

ERI will be unable to sample wells MW4 and MW12 during future sampling events.


