To Whom It May Concern:

At the request of ExxonMobil Environmental Service (EMES), on behalf of Exxon Mobil Corporation, Cardno ERI is installing two off-site groundwater monitoring wells (MW20 and MW21) as part of the ongoing environmental investigation at the subject site. The proposed well locations are shown on the attached Generalized Site Plan. Work is being performed at the direction of the Alameda County Environmental Health.

Borehole clearance and well installation activities are scheduled to occur May 7 and 8, 2014. Well development and survey activities will be scheduled for a later date and you will be notified at least 48 hours in advance.

Soil cuttings and rinsate water from drilling activities will be placed in 55-gallon drums and stored at the site pending characterization and disposal. Upon receipt of laboratory analytical results of soil samples from the drums, Cardno ERI will coordinate with EMES for disposal of the soil and water. Cardno ERI appreciates your cooperation to ensure that field work occurs safely and efficiently. Though the work is being performed off site, personnel will need to meet on site each morning to conduct health and safety meetings and coordinate activities for the day. In addition, work vehicles may need to be on site while not in use. Cardno ERI will identify vehicles that will be on site and coordinate parking of the vehicles with you or your designated representative.
