At the request of ExxonMobil Environmental Services Company, on behalf of ExxonMobil Oil Corporation (ExxonMobil), and pursuant to email correspondence with Alameda County Health Care Services Agency Department of Environmental Health (ACEH), Environmental Resolutions, Inc. (ERI) prepared this addendum to the *Work Plan for Well Installation* dated April 27, 2009 (Work Plan). The Work Plan proposed installation of six on-site (MW16A, MW16B, MW17A, MW17B, MW19A, and MW19C) and two off-site groundwater monitoring wells (MW18A and MW18B).

PRE-FIELD ACTIVITIES

In preparation for the drilling activities, ERI personnel contacted the Alameda County Assessor (the County) to determine the property owner for the parcel where groundwater monitoring wells MW18A and MW18B locations were originally proposed. The County notified ERI personnel that the parcel was part of the roadway. ERI personnel then contacted the City of Oakland Permit Counter (the City) to determine if obstruction permits would be required to work on the parcel. The City notified ERI that the area is part of the City right-of-way and, as such, would require a Minor Encroachment Permit. The permitting process for a Minor Encroachment Permit may take up to one year to complete.

REVISED DRILLING ACTIVITIES

In order to complete groundwater monitoring well installations in a timely manner, ERI proposes that the proposed locations of groundwater monitoring wells MW18A and MW18B be moved approximately 25 feet to the northeast and back onto the subject property. The attached plate shows the original proposed locations and the new locations. The purpose of the proposed wells is to replace monitoring well MW4, which was paved over. ERI feels that the new location will serve this purpose.

For any reports cited that were not generated by ERI, the data taken from those reports is used "as is" and is assumed to be accurate. ERI does not guarantee the accuracy of this data and makes no warranties for the referenced work performed nor the inferences or conclusions stated in these reports.

This report was prepared in accordance with generally accepted standards of environmental, geological, and engineering practices in California at the time of investigation. No soil engineering or geotechnical

references are implied or should be inferred. The evaluation of the geologic conditions at the site for this investigation is made from a limited number of data points. Subsurface conditions may vary away from these data points.


