Jerry,

As we discussed in our October 7, 2010 meeting, CRA on behalf of Shell proposes the following two changes to the established groundwater monitoring program for the subject site.

- Due to detections of Cr<sup>6+</sup> and chlorinated solvents, we will suspend sampling of MW-9. Initial discussions with representatives of the adjacent former Francis Plating facility indicate that they are interested in taking over responsibility for the well.
- In order to better quantify trends in on-site TBA concentrations, we will increase the monitoring frequency for MW-6 and MW-7 from semiannual to quarterly. We will continue to provide groundwater monitoring reports to ACEH semiannually following the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter groundwater monitoring events.
