We have received your written approval of our September 15, 1998 Additional Investigation Work Plan prepared for the above-referenced site. As you requested, we are clarifying the following points:

- The inferred ground water flow direction shown on Figure 1 was obtained from a site map created by the previous consultant. A map of the area (State of California Department of Water Resources Map, Oakland West Quadrangle) was checked to verify the inferred ground water flow direction based on topography.
- We will submit a minimum of one soil sample per boring for laboratory analysis for total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) by modified EPA Method 8015, and benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX) and methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE) by EPA Method 8020. The highest MTBE concentrations detected in each boring by EPA Method 8020 will be confirmed by EPA Method 8260.

We will obtain the necessary permits, schedule drilling activities, and provide your office with a schedule of activities. If you require any additional information, please call me at (510) 420-3312.
