
Dear Mr. Gholami:

Thanks for discussing the status of the site investigation with me today. As I indicated, the workplan for the investigation prepared by ERAS Environmental, Inc. on September 22, 2000, proposed three groundwater wells with 3/4-inch diameter casing. An addendum to the workplan, dated December 29, 2000, was submitted to you that added three additional soil borings to the investigation.

Subsequently, it was decided by ERAS client to pursue reimbursement for previous and future corrective action costs from the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund (USTCF). It has also come to our attention the originally proposed wells are not considered suitable for groundwater investigations by the USTCF. Therefore, it is hereby proposed the three wells will be constructed with standard 2-inch diameter casing in order to not jeopardize future potential reimbursement.

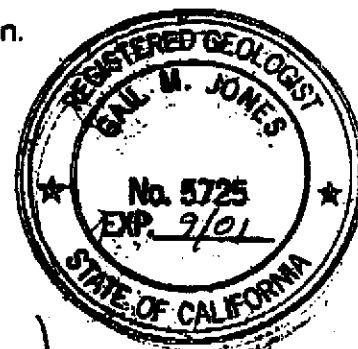
Dear Mr. Gholami:

On behalf of Mr. Trinh Hoang, the current owner of the subject site, the following is an addendum to the Workplan for Soil and Groundwater Investigation for the subject site prepared by ERAS Environmental, Inc. (ERAS), dated September 22, 2000. The additional work proposed herein is based on the request for additional information in your letter dated December 6, 2000 and the conversations between Ms. Gail Jones of ERAS and you.

Three additional soil borings will be drilled in the approximate locations shown on the attached Figure 2. Grab groundwater samples will be collected from each boring and analyzed for the presence of petroleum hydrocarbons including MTBE.

The last part of the last paragraph regarding the Geology section on page 3 of the workplan was inadvertently left out. The last sentence of text should read "In AEI-2 the silt was encountered below the clay at a depth of approximately 13 feet."

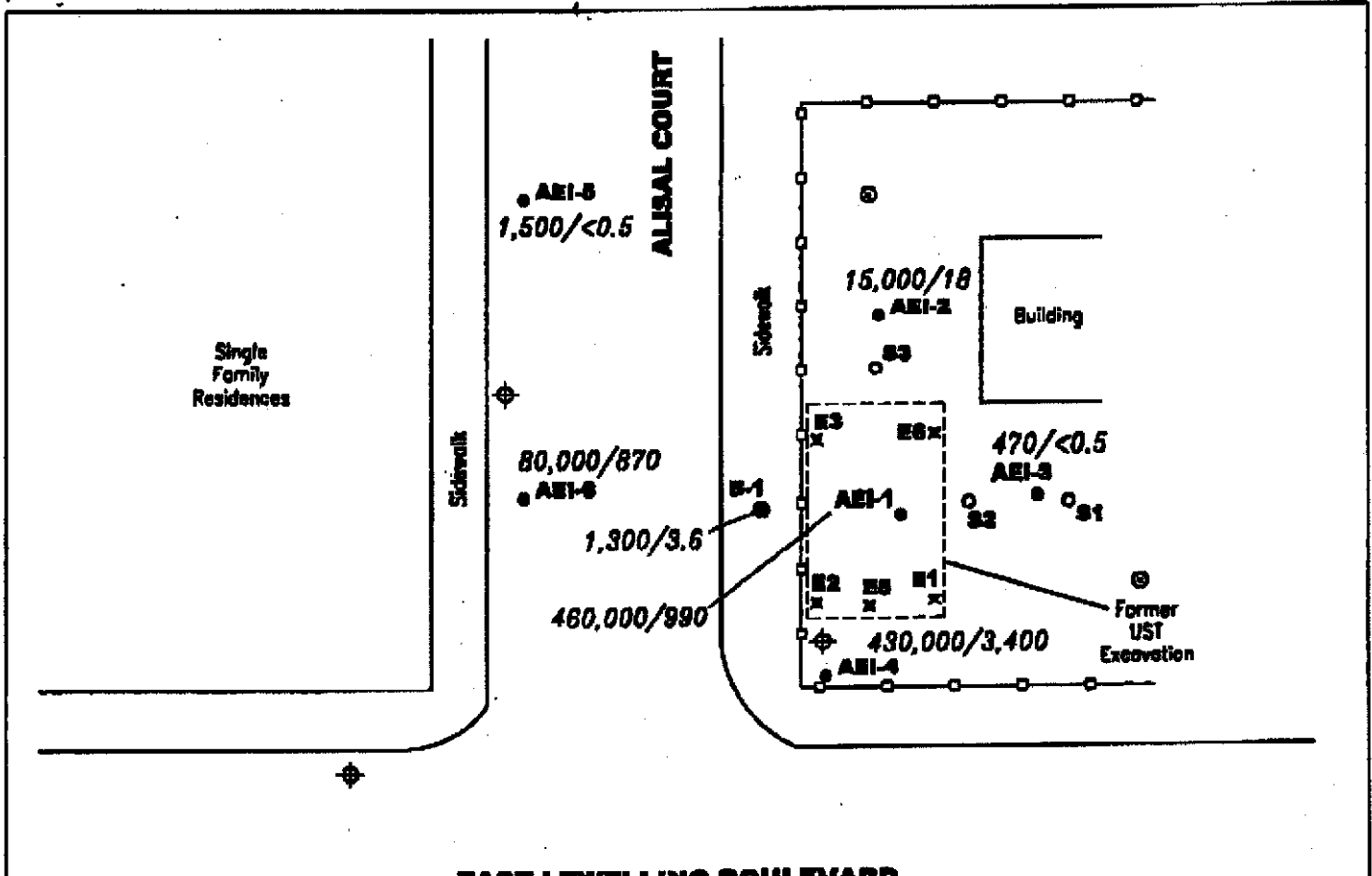

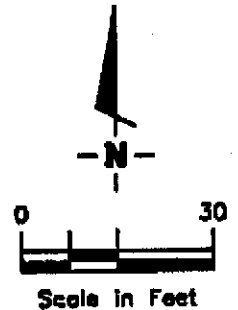


**EAST LEWELLING BOULEVARD**
