Gentlemen:

Chevron removed five tanks from this site on April 21, 1988. There were three 10,000 gal., one 6,000 gal. and one 1,000 gal. fiberglass underground tanks. Attached is the sampling-testing report on this removal prepared by Blaine Tech Services, Inc.

Groundwater was encountered in the tank holes during the uncovering. At the site of the 6,000 gal. tank, 3,500 gallons of water contaminated with gasoline released during the uncovering was pumped out and delivered to our Oakland Asphalt plant for recycling. Interface soil samples taken from this location indicated no hydrocarbons remained in the tank hole.

Interface soil samples were also taken in the main tank hole, Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH) ranged from 34 ppm to 890 ppm.

The sample from the waste oil tank hole had 14,000 ppm total oil and grease and 4300 ppm high boiling point hydrocarbons. Additional soil was excavated from the area around the waste oil tank, manifested and hauled to Kettleman City, California for disposal. The soil sample taken after the additional excavation indicated no oil or grease was present.

Backfill excavated to groundwater level in the main tank hole was aerated on site and used in backfilling the pipe trenches and tank holes.

The site has 13 monitoring wells in place and a remediation plan is being developed by Crowley Environmental Services, Oakland, California. This will be submitted to your office when completed.
