#### Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

### Responsible Party Identification

#### Existence of Unauthorized Release

Shell owned and operated a service station at 2350 Harrison Street in Oakland until 1977. The underground storage tanks (USTs) obtained tank removal permits from the City of Oakland and apparently removed the USTs in March 1977; however, no documentation of the tank removal has been found. Mr. Richard Burge purchased the property from Shell on May 31, 1977 after the USTs were removed. Petroleum-contaminated soils were detected during the installation of two light poles on the site in November 1992. Petroleum contamination was also detected in soils from four additional soil borings advanced on March 4, 1993.

#### Responsible Party Identification

Shell Oil Products US owned the USTs and property and operated the USTs until the USTs were removed and the site sold in 1977. Shell Oil Products US is the primary responsible party because the unauthorized release occurred during the time that Shell Oil Products US owned and operated USTs at the time of an unauthorized release (Definition 1), was the owner of property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3), and had control of USTs at the time of or following an unauthorized release (Definition 4).

Mr. Richard Burge is a responsible party because he is the current owner of the property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3).
