Left msg for David Glick w/ Geo Plexus. Asked him to send me stockpile soil results that were reported to me during our June 1995 call.

Spoke w/ Mr. Gallagher & gave him a status. He wants a letter from us re: stockpiled soil. I told him as soon as I receive & review lab reports from June 1995 sampling, I would send a letter.

Spoke w/ Glick re: soil remediation & site status. I told him to forward to me the May 1995 results which we had discussed in June 1995. Regarding Stockpile Soil sampling & to also include a summary of where all this soil originated from [He said the 510 cy (7.50 cy) was comprised of 2/15/96]

Discussed letter w/ Mr. Gallagher. He said he would continue gw monitoring

- 1/28/94 Lee Hickins, Tank Protect, called to say that he collected soil samples from the 180 cy of stockpiled soil. He collected one per every 20 yd<sup>3</sup> and found that most of it was ND. He requested to reuse this soil on-site. I requested that he submit a summary of sampling strategy or lab analysis results.
- 9/13/94 David Glick 408-987-0210 Drilling has been scheduled for Sept 15 '94 at site.
- 9/15/94 Mr. Gallagher called to say wells have been drilled.
- 6/7/95 David Glick called regarding stockpiled soil sample results. One core approx. 500-600 cy was sampled. TPHg 2.8-31 ppm, TPHd 13-65 ppm & benzene ND for 16 samples analyzed. I told him ideally samples should be ND & we will allow on-site disposal of soil w/out a permit if TPH < 10 ppm & benzene is ND. He said there is a IQR '95 dated 3/95 & will forward it to me A.S.A.P.
- 8/15/95 David Glick called re: stockpiled soil results. He is sending a letter w/results. Samples were ND for TPHg & BTEX and TPHd, although an isolated peak was detected in the TPHd range which they believe is carbon material sprayed on for bioaugmentation. RP wants to reuse this soil as a cover on-site. Told him I needed to review the file & then we could have a conf. call w/ Mr. Gallagher.

Mr. Marker stated that no efforts have yet been made to implement the approved work plan due to financial difficulties. He also stated that Forni has not officially received access permission from its neighbors due to the death of one of the property owners of the neighboring property. Apparently, the neighboring property is under litigation as to who will take over the property. He said that two brothers are fighting over property.

According to Mr. Marker, Forni declared bankruptcy in 1990 (Chapter 11 bankruptcy). They still have one more year to go on that claim. The owners & operators of the property are one in the same: Barry Gallagher & Linda Sayer. →

The bankruptcy # is 4-03121-T-3  
the court they filed in is in Oakland.

I stated that I would discuss  
this situation w/ the DA's office.

Mr. Marker stated that if they had  
the money they would do the work.

I requested that he periodically  
update this office to let us know  
if they can anticipate when any  
work can begin at the site.

Mr. Marker also mentioned that  
the stockpiled soil is still on site  
uncovered. I told him that if his  
erecting the soil, he needs to  
notify BAAQMD. If he doesn't  
notify BAAQMD, then he must cover  
piles. I also told him that if it  
rains, he must have the soil  
adequately bermed and covered.

He will get started on implementing soil investigation work plan once an agreement form is drawn up by the neighbors attorney (which should take ~ 1 week). I asked Mr. Markur to get back in touch w/ me in a week regardless of whether or not the agreement is drawn up or not - just to update me.

Mr. Markur stated that the neighbors attorney hadn't gotten around to drafting an agreement form, so Mr. Markur got an attorney to draft one up, which should be completed by Wednesday.
