UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND (FUND) NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND CLAIM FROM PRIORITY LIST: CLAIM NUMBER 016440 FOR SITE ADDRESS 121 98TH AVENUE, OAKLAND

On, June 1, 2016, Fund staff sent an email requesting documentation as it appeared that the claimant's name, entity type, and tax identification Number (TIN) had changed.

The Fund's records reflect the claimant's name as, Budget Rent A Car System, Inc. Documents submitted on April 19, 2016, reflected the claimant's name as, Budget Rent a Car System, LLC. Also, the TIN reflected on the documents submitted did not reflect the TIN currently associated with this claim.

In the e-mail mentioned above, the Fund requested the claimant to complete and submit the following form:


A request to the Fund Manager must include, at a minimum: (1) a statement describing how the claimant is damaged by the prior Staff Decision; (2) a description of the remedy or outcome desired; and (3) an explanation of why the claimant believes the Staff Decision is erroneous, inappropriate or improper.

If you do not request a review by the Fund Manager within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, the Staff Decision will then become final and conclusive and your claim will be removed from the Priority List at the end of the 30-day period.

If you correct the grounds for suspension, your claim will be reinstated to its previous placement on the Priority List.
