Spoke to Tom Graf in response to Jan 19 '95 Workplan Revision. Requested info on what type & size of filter is proposed for the diesel; stated that wells should be left overnight to recharge & attempt to obtain as much water sample as possible to prevent higher detection limits; stated that SO₂/O₃ & gas analysis proposed near the former waste oil tank wouldn't be necessary based on ND results for these constituents in soils. Soil & g.w. samples collected from SB-1 in past. Lead analysis is still necessary.

Future w.p.s need an attached cov letter signed by R.P. Requested elaboration on the point of installing one boring b.g. of Tank "A" & requested that they address the County's carbon requirement for permanent wells. Also requested a timeline.

RE: STID 3522, located at 1521 Buena Vista Ave, Alameda

According to Mr. Lewis, groundwater samples, from Tank Pits T-1 and T-3, were collected. Tank Pit T-1 was excavated along the sidewalls to Non Detect. However, Tank Pit T-1 was not excavated downwards (vertically) to Non Detect.

The above-ground waste oil tank was removed along w/
concrete slab rubble and some soil. Although soil sample
collected from beneath waste oil tank (i.e., bottom of
excavation) detected 750 ppm oil and grease, no additional soil
was excavated, and the 750 ppm oil and grease was left in
place.

It wasn't noted in the Final Closure Report, but piping was
removed for T-3.

Mrs. Black is Blymer Engineers, Inc. are consultants for Peter Wang of Encinal Terminals. They are preparing a work plan that will address the installation of monitoring wells on site. Sue Black is working on this site. Ms. Black called to say that it wasn't too practical to analyze groundwater samples for oil and grease, when none of the proposed groundwater wells would be downgradient of the former waste oil tank location. She suggested that, instead of analyzing groundwater samples for oil and grease, that a soil boring be drilled separately at downgradient of the former waste oil tank and soil & groundwater samples be collected & analyzed for oil & grease. Ms. Shin stated that this would be okay.
