This letter is to inform you that soils excavation planned at the referenced station has been postponed until the week of December 14, 1992. The former station building has been demolished, however present weather and soil conditions are not conducive to completion of the soils excavation.

The proposed downgradient groundwater monitoring well (OMW-9) discussed in PACIFIC's letter dated October 7, 1992 is scheduled for installation in January, pending receipt of the appropriate permits. The well will be installed adjacent to the median on Castro Valley Boulevard (Figure 1).

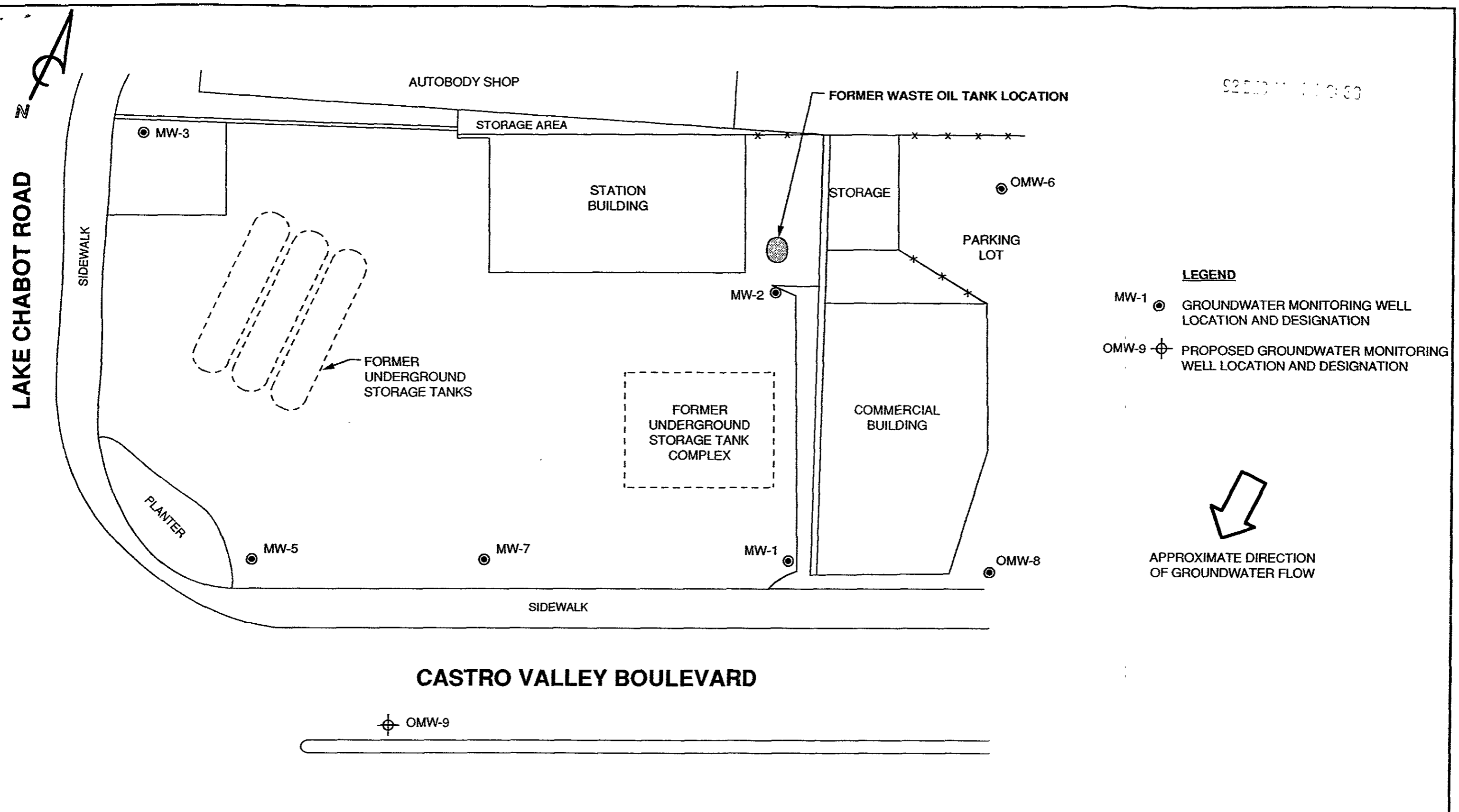
