Dear Mr. McCoy:

I am in receipt of the document "Soil Sampling and Analysis" dated March 18, 1993, prepared by ACC Consultants for the above referenced project. Based on the review of the submitted information, this Department still requires that the following additional work be conducted on site:

- 1. Although concrete fuel dispensing islands were removed from the site in 1979, there are no records of the tank being located or removed. Since the status of the underground storage tanks are not known at this time, this Department would require that an investigation, like a magnetometer survey be done to confirm the presence or absence of tanks on site.
- 2. Six borings installed by ACC in the southwest patio area, revealed the presence of gasoline in boring B-4 in both soil and groundwater, at concentrations of 1200 ppm and 6300 ppb respectively. Although benzene was not detected above the detection limit in any of the samples, the detection limits for benzene in sample B2 and B4 (the 2 samples where gasoline was identified), were 170 ppb and 100 ppb. These detection limits are higher than the available cleanup numbers for a phase I investigation. Hence, additional investigation must be performed around boring B-4, to define the extent of contamination both in the soil and groundwater.
