Mark - we opened our case #01S0454 on 11/22/1996 about a month after your agency closed it. I have no available information that there is a different problem associated with it. More likely we just assigned a case no. to get the database complete with a local agency # and a RB #. My recommendation is to delete the duplicate record (RB case#) since it has no info and no one is working on it. Thanks
