Subject: Site Status Update for ARCO Station 2152, 22141 Center Street, Castro Valley, California.

Dear Mr. Seery:

This letter provides an update on investigation and remedial activities conducted for the above-referenced site. This update covers site activities performed during August 1991 through October 1991, and site activities anticipated for the month of November 1991.

**Status of Previous Months Activities:**

- August 22, 1991:** Performed third quarter 1991 quarterly groundwater monitoring and sampling. Onsite wells MW-1, MW-2, MW-3, MW-4, MW-5 and MW-6 were sampled for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX), and total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH)-as-gasoline.
- September 12, 1991:** Received a letter from Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA) detailing questions and concerns regarding site assessment and remedial activities to date that need to be addressed.
- September 18, 1991:** Conducted monthly monitoring of groundwater wells to determine depth-to-water in each well.

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- September 19, 1991: Submitted to ARCO for review a draft response letter addressing questions and concerns ACHCSA detailed in their letter dated September 4, 1991.
- October 14, 1991: Initiated compiling all necessary information to obtain an Authority-to-Construct/Permit-to-Operate from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) to allow for discharge of treated offgases from vapor extraction system to the atmosphere.
- October 21, 1991: Submitted final Workplan for Additional Subsurface Investigation and Design and Permitting of Vapor Extraction System to ARCO and governing agencies.
- October 22, 1991: Submitted final Third Quarter Groundwater Monitoring Report to ARCO and governing agencies.

**Anticipated Work to be performed in the Next Month:**

- o Continue groundwater monitoring and sampling program for this site.
- o Submit to BAAQMD a completed Authority-to-Construct/Permit-to-Operate Application to allow for installation of the proposed vapor extraction system.
- o Initiate bid package preparation to install the proposed vapor-extraction system.
