This letter provides an update on investigation and remedial activities conducted for the above-referenced site. This update covers site activities performed during January 1992, and site activities anticipated for the month of February 1992.

**Status of Previous Months Activities:**

- January 18, 1992: Monthly monitoring of groundwater monitoring wells performed to determine depth-to-water in each well.
- January 19, 1992 Generation of Plans and Specifications for submission to the City of Castro Valley Building, Planning, and Fire Departments to secure a building permit prior to installation of the proposed vapor abatement system initiated.
- January 23, 1992 Sent letter of intent to proceed with Work Plan for Additional Subsurface Investigation and Design and Permitting of Vapor Extraction System (RESNA, October 1991) to Scott Seery of Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA).
- January 24, 1992: Received approval on Authority-to-Construct/Permit-to-Operate Application from Bay Area Air Quality Management District


