- o Proceed with generation of Plans and Specifications to the City of Castro Valley Building, Planning, and Fire Departments to secure a building permit prior to installation of the proposed vapor abatement system.
- o Initiate bid package preparation to install the proposed vapor-extraction system upon ACHCSA approval.
