This letter provides an update on investigation and remedial activities conducted for the above-referenced site. This update covers site activities performed during March 1992, and site activities anticipated for the month of April 1992.

March 1992 Activities

- Submitted Fourth Quarter 1991 Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Report to ARCO and governing regulatory agencies.
- Performed quarterly groundwater monitoring and sampling.
- Sent Scott Seery of Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA) a response to his letter of February 4, 1992.
- Telecom from Scott Seery of ACHCSA on March 24, 1992, to inform us that Castro Valley doesn't have a Public Works Department; therefore, we have to go through Alameda County Public Works Department to permit the proposed vapor extraction system (VES).
- Proceeded with Plans and Specifications of the proposed VES to submit to the Alameda County Public Works Department, City of Castro Valley Building,

Planning, and Fire Departments to secure a building permit prior to the installation of the proposed VES.


- Initiated report preparation for onsite soil borings drilled and sampled on February 12 and 13, 1992.
