ASSUMING A WESTERLY GROUNDWATER FLOW DIRECTION, THE NEAREST CREEK IS VILLAGE CREEK, ~1850' AWAY, WHERE IT IS CULVERTED INTO A RIGHT ANGLE TURN AT DOWLING PARK.

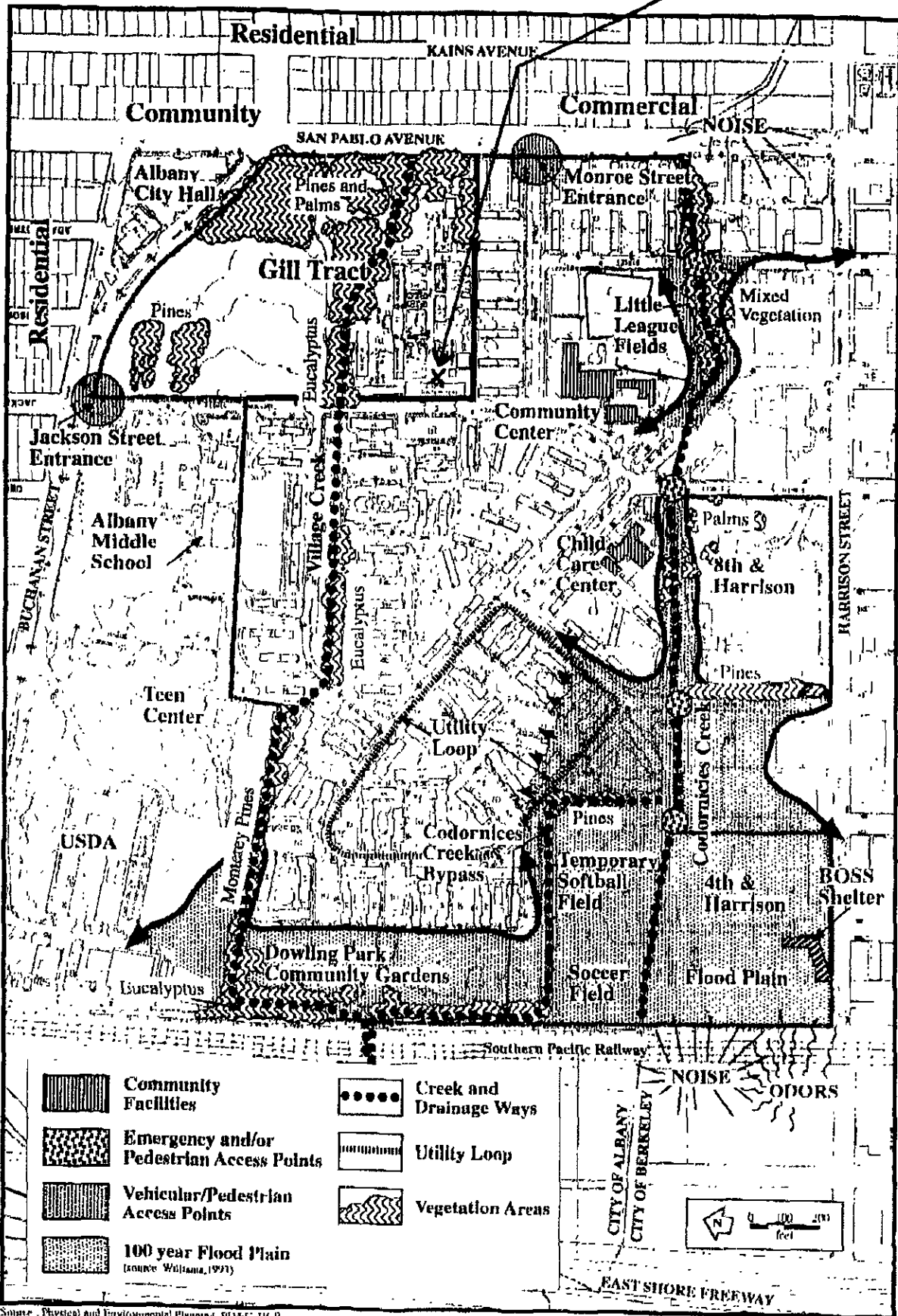
